The Early Years Foundation Stage

- In Nursery we have created a safe and nurturing environment- this help children to settle and become confident learners
- The Nursery team are there to support children's needs- we go from the children's interests and what motivates them





Typical session in Nursery

- Spare set of named wellies that can be left at Nursery




Family Learning

In Nursery we recognise the importance of parent/carer partnerships and invite parents/carers in on a regular basis to take part in lots of fun learning activities with your child.





Outside exploration



We go outside regularly to take part in forest-school style learning.















Tapestry

We use Tapestry in Nursery to capture your child's learning. Tapestry is an online learning journey which you can access at home to view your child's learning and achievements. Parents/carers are also able to upload pictures and videos of the lovely things you do as a family outside of Nursery. Time is then given for children to share their 'Wow moments' with their friends.















How to prepare your child for Nursery

Please keep practising:

- Helping your child to wash and dry their hands properly
- Helping your child to wipe their nose when needed
- Helping your child become independent with dressing- putting on their own socks and shoes, putting on their own coats and zipping them up
- Helping your child to use a toilet independently, wiping themselves properly and flushing the toilet











What will Nursery look like in September?

In September parents and carers and invited in for an initial family meeting with the Nursery Team. This is a great time to chat about your child and for you to ask us any questions that you might have.

There will then be a settling period to allow your child to settle into Nursery and form secure attachments with the Nursery Team.
