

Year 10 Philosophy and Ethics Theology

Term 1	Hinduism	Hindu Beliefs	Pupils explore key Hindu beliefs including Brahman, atman, karma, samsara, moksha, dharma, and the importance of deities and sacred texts within Hindu traditions.
Term 2	Hinduism and Christianity	Hindu Practices and Christian Beliefs	Pupils study Hindu worship, pilgrimage, festivals, and daily practices before beginning key Christian beliefs including the nature of God, creation, the Trinity, salvation, and the life and teachings of Jesus.
Term 3	Christianity	Christian Practices	Pupils explore worship, prayer, sacraments, pilgrimage, festivals, the role of the Church, and Christianity in the local and global community.

Philosophy

Term 1

Theme B: Religion and Life and Theme D: Religion, Peace and Conflict

Pupils explore religious and non-religious beliefs about the origins of the universe, environmental responsibility, abortion, euthanasia, war, violence, terrorism, pacifism, forgiveness, and justice.

Term 2

Themes E and F: Religion, Crime and Punishment and Religion, Human Rights and Social Justice

Pupils investigate justice, punishment, equality, prejudice, discrimination, wealth and poverty, freedom, and human rights from religious and non-religious perspectives.

Term 3

Christianity, Hinduism and Thematic Studies Revision

Pupils revisit key knowledge, religious teachings, exam skills, and evaluation techniques across Hinduism, Christianity, and all thematic studies in preparation for GCSE examinations.
