Term 1	CC Health and RSE	Health Checks, Party Drugs, Sex and Pressure	Pupils learn about physical and mental health, screening and health checks, the risks associated with party drugs, healthy relationships, sexual pressure, and making informed decisions.
Term 2	CC Wider World	British Values, Protest and Extremism	Pupils explore democracy, individual liberty, mutual respect, tolerance, protest movements, radicalisation, and the dangers of extremism.
Term 3	CC and RS Theology	Alternative Religions and Prejudice	Pupils investigate alternative religious movements and beliefs, whilst exploring themes of prejudice, discrimination, tolerance, and respect in modern society.

Term 1	CC Wider World	Careers, Post-16 and Exam Preparation	Pupils prepare for life beyond secondary school by exploring post-16 pathways, careers, employability skills, revision techniques, and exam wellbeing strategies.
Term 2	CC/RS Health	Toxic and Abusive Relationships, Religious Values and the 21st Century	Pupils explore unhealthy and abusive relationships, coercion, respect, and support networks, alongside discussions about religious values and modern ethical issues in contemporary society.
Term 3	CC Wider World	Revision and GCSE Support	Pupils receive support with revision skills, stress management, organisation, study techniques, and preparation for GCSE examinations and future pathways.
