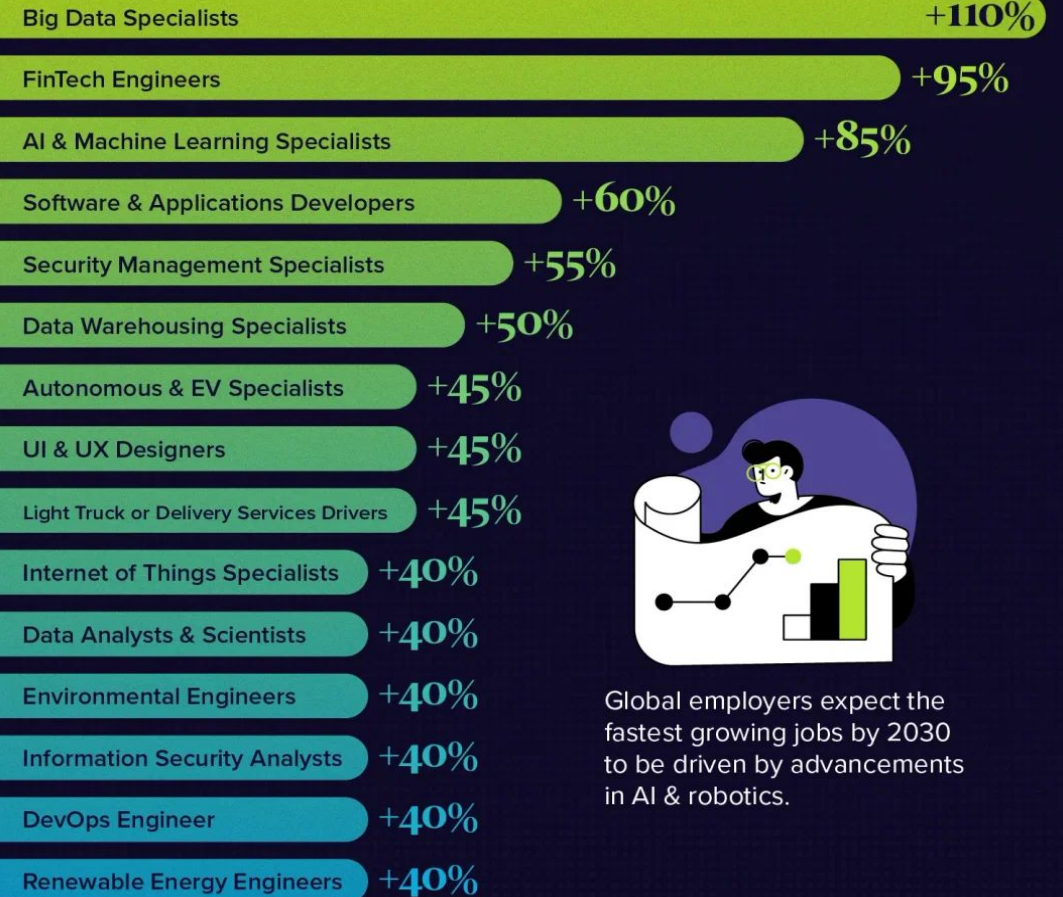

Key Drivers for These Trends in the UK

- **Green transition:** Large projected growth in clean energy (wind, solar, sustainability).
- **Digital transformation:** AI, data, cybersecurity remain core as companies digitise.
- **Public services strain:** Education and healthcare roles are growing due to shortages / demand.
- **Infrastructure & logistics:** Investment into transport, construction, and delivery networks.

UK Job Growth Forecast: 2025–2030

Sectors with Highest Projected Growth

1. Digital & Technology

- Strong demand for *programmers and software development professionals*: +87,000 extra roles projected. [GOV.UK+1](#)
- Also demand for *IT business analysts, system designers, architects*. [Digital Education Resource Archive](#)
- Roles in AI are expected to contribute significantly. [GOV.UK](#)

2. Adult Social Care

- The **largest single occupation** by number of new roles: care workers and home carers — ~90,000 extra roles projected by 2030. [GOV.UK+1](#)
- This is driven by demographic pressure and increasing demand for care provision.

3. Construction

- Very high projected employment growth in the **housebuilding** sub-sector. [GOV.UK](#)

4. Clean Energy / Engineering

- Clean Energy Industries are forecast to have *very rapid growth*. [Digital Education Resource Archive](#)
- Engineering roles across sectors (civil engineers, electrical engineers, engineering technicians) are also highlighted as priority occupations. [GOV.UK](#)

- **A Levels**
- **T Levels**
 - Equivalent to 3 A Levels.
 - 80% time in the classroom and 20% on a 45-day placement to equip you with the knowledge and skills companies are looking for.
- **BTEC/CTEC**
 - Can be equivalent to 1, 2 or 3 A Levels.
 - Career-based qualifications designed to give students the skills they need to move on to higher education or go straight into employment.
- **Apprenticeships**
 - A paid job where the employee learns and gains valuable experiences.
 - Alongside on-the-job training, apprentices spend at least 20% of their working hours completing classroom-based learning with a college, university or training provider which leads to a nationally recognised qualification.
- **Level 1 and Level 2 qualifications**

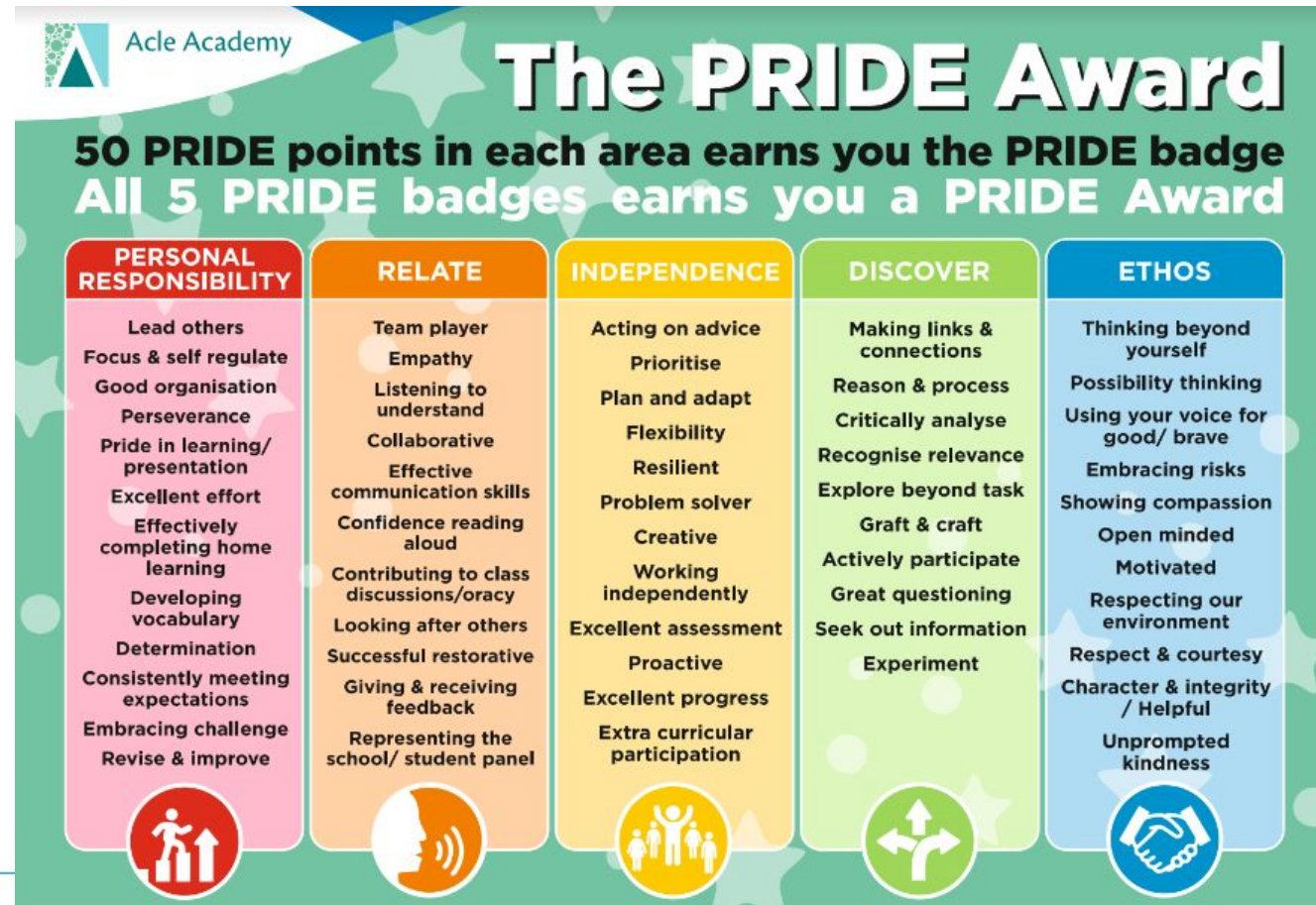
