As the advice regarding Covid-19 changes almost daily, it is becoming more apparent the impact this could have on all of us.

We have no cases of Covid-19 but have taken the following decisions to reduce the risk of infection.

- Sports fixtures against other schools will be cancelled until further notice. Some sports clubs after school will continue.
- The instrumental concert planned for 19th March has been cancelled.
- Visits and trips for students will be postponed or cancelled until Easter including the trips to Snettisham and Cambridge University.
- Citizenship Day on Friday 20th March will be a normal school day to avoid outside speakers visiting.
- The Parent and Discussion Group planned for 23rd March has been cancelled.
- The Wonderfest trip to the UEA on 25th March has been postponed.
- The vocal concert planned for 24th March has been cancelled.
- The year 11 Power to Perform evening on 26th March has been postponed.
- The trip to watch Leicester Tigers play Bath Rugby on 27th March has been cancelled.
- The Rock to 11 concert rehearsal planned for 28th March and the actual event planned for 31st March has been postponed. A full refund will be given to those who have purchased tickets.
- Following the advice given to all schools we have also had to postpone the French trip and our Music Tour in July. We will contact the parents of students booked on these trips individually.

Please continue to follow the advice shared publicly and encourage hand washing with soap and hot water. If your child has to remain at home due to Covid-19 please tell us. This is a decision for you as parents and carers. We would expect brothers and sisters living at the same address to follow the same procedures. All schools have been asked to record all reasons for absence.
