Q. Do you have the same teacher everyday?


A. Some classes do but in Year 3 you will have the same teacher for three days (Mon-Wed) and then a different teacher for the last two days (Thu-Fri)

Lunch

Q. Do you get milk at break times?

A. No, we don't serve milk at break so you can drink from your water bottle. At lunch, you can buy a juice if you would like.

A. Yes, if you are having a school lunch then you will collect a tray when you go into the hall. Children who are packed lunch sit on separate tables to school lunch.

Q. What sports do you offer?


A. In PE Year 3 & 4 do the same sports and then they change in Year 5 & 6.
