Dear Parents / Carers,

Whilst we have been waiting for the government to define the 'Key Worker' role and 'vulnerable pupils', we have moved forward with our interim plans.

For those pupils eligible (that is children of key workers and those identified as 'vulnerable') to be in school from Monday, all Wensum Trust schools will be open. We feel it is only right that we maintain some stability for all our pupils, staff, parents and carers whilst following government directive to limit social interactions.

For now our plan is to keep all schools open to those eligible up until Easter. However, this is subject to possible change should we not be able to staff all schools or indeed the uptake from eligible pupils is not sufficient to keep all schools open. We are in very quick changing times. Next week, we will update all parents of our plans for the Easter break onwards.

Our kitchens will be open for those who are eligible for Free School Meals. Information will be sent from your school tomorrow.
