capital city	A capital city is a city, specified by law or constitution, by the government of a country, or part of a country, such as a state, province or county. It usually serves as the location for a country's
continents	A continent is a large continuous mass of land.
Europe	A continent located entirely in the Northern Hemisphere.
Italy	A country located in southern Europe.
landmark	An object or feature of a landscape or town that is easily seen and recognized from a distance, especially one that enables someone to establish their

population	All the inhabitants of a particular place.
Rome	The capital city of Italy.
United Kingdom	A country in north-western Europe that is not part of the main land mass.
