The other platform you may be asked to do work on is ezyscience, which you have all accessed in lessons.



The first of these is www.mymaths.co.uk itself. The school login is peel and the school password is radius. You will then need to use your own extra individual login and password to gain access to the work that has been set for you. Here you will also find lessons on the topics that have been set. These will help you complete the homework.

The second place is vie.mathswatch.com If your name is, for example, James (or Jane) Smith then your username would be JSmith@aldermanpeel The password is Qwerty123 Here you will find hundreds of short videos that will help you with anything you might be finding difficult on mymaths.
