Use **vle.mathswatch.com** (Username: JSmith@aldermanpeel Password: Qwerty123) to find the appropriate topics, watch the video clips and follow the instructions of the nice lady. There are also (at least) 6 practice GCSE papers for you to attempt on mathswatch - do them carefully and mathswatch will mark them and tell you your grade as you progress through the paper.

Use your **GCSE Revision Guide or Workbook** for extra practice questions (answers are at the back of the book).
