As well as full planning and daily lesson packs, Twinkl Phonics contains a large range of supplementary resources such as GPC flashcards, wall friezes, phoneme fans, sounds mats, songs, interactive games, home learning activities and spelling

bookmarks. Decodable reading materials are provided through Twinkl Phonics minibooks and our fully aligned phonetically decodable reading scheme, Rhino Readers. A schedule of assessment is provided and supported by fully resourced assessment packs for each Level of learning in line with the Whole Scheme Overview planning document. Further assessment support is available through the programme Handbook and online training course.
