

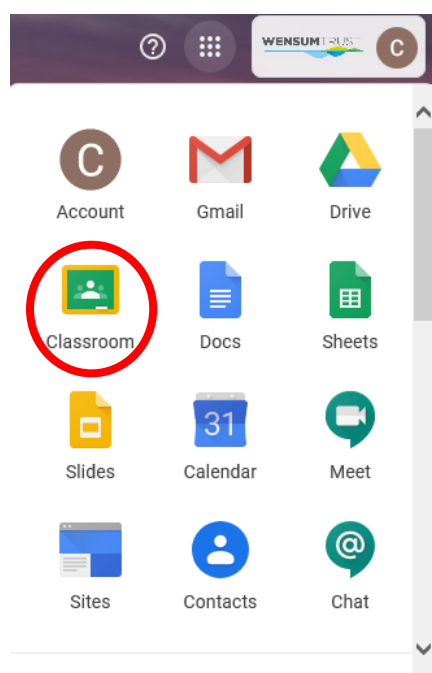
Google Classrooms – Parent Information

Google Classroom is a free and secure learning network for teachers, students and schools. It provides a safe way for us to connect, share content, access homework, participate in discussions and receive class information.

Using Google Classroom allows you and your child to have access to course work at any time through the Internet and is accessible online and through any device.

Teachers have created Classrooms and started to invite students. Students will receive an email to their Acle email for each class they are invited to. This email will come from Google, informing your student to which class they are invited, and by which teacher.

Once the invite is accepted, you can find Google classroom by visiting <https://classroom.google.com/>, opening the app on Android devices, or by navigating to the apps menu in an internet browser as shown below.



Email Logins

All students should know their logins as these are used regularly within school. The login format is **username@acle.norfolk.sch.uk**.

If your child is unsure of their username, there is a format, depending on your year group.

Years 7, 8: Last name followed by the first two letters of the first name. E.g.: John Smith becomes SmithJo, and his email address would be SmithJo@acle.norfolk.sch.uk

Years 9, 10 & 11: Intake year, followed by last name, followed by first initial.

The intake years are: 17 for year 9, 16 for year 10 and 15 for year 11. E.g: John Smith in year 9 becomes 17SmithJ and his email address would be 17SmithJ@acle.norfolk.sch.uk.
