



## Year 11 Results Day 2020

On **Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August 2020**, Year 11 students will be able to collect their GCSE and Vocational Results for summer 2020. As these awarded grades will be the result of a government-led process and not as a direct result of students sitting exams, this will understandably be an unusual experience for us all.

We are committed to ensure that all students are able to receive their grades in a safe but supportive way so we have made the following arrangements to ensure that this can happen.

Results **will be available from 10:00am** but in order to ensure that we can maintain social distancing requirements, we are asking groups of students to arrive at the following times:

10:00 – Mersey House  
10:20 – Trent House  
10:40 – Waveney House  
11:00 – Shannon House

Please arrive at the allotted time to avoid unnecessary crowding.

Upon arrival to school, we ask that students - and any accompanying family members - enter via Entrance 1 (near Waveney Close) and **walk around to the back of the school to the school playground**. Parents and family members are welcome to wait on the playground while students follow the one-way system into the science cloakrooms where they will collect their results envelopes. These will be arranged alphabetically for collection. Yearbooks and Hoodies will also be available for those who ordered them.

We ask that students then open their envelopes outside on the playground so that we can keep numbers inside to a minimum. **Please observe current social distancing guidance at all times.**

We do not currently have any details on the process for appeals or re-sits at this time. We are anxiously waiting for this information to be clarified by central government and we will share this as soon as we are able to. In order to ensure that we can keep contact with students **please complete [this survey](#)** so that we have an alternative email address and mobile number for you.

If you wish to discuss your results with a member of staff, please **use the 'GCSE Results Query Form'** in your results envelope and hand it in to a member of staff so that we can arrange a time to talk further over the following days/weeks. Our capacity to field lots of queries on the day will be limited so we will need to prioritise any students who need the most support. However, our careers advisor will also be available for 1:1 meetings with students on the day.

If you are unable to collect your results in person and wish for someone else to collect them on your behalf, **we must have written permission from you** [the student] for this person to do so. The designated person will need to bring photographic ID with them when they come in to collect your results.

Finally, **please return any GCSE textbooks or resources** that you have borrowed during your GCSEs.
