

WHAT TO DO if you have a suspected or confirmed case of Covid-19 in your household

Your child or someone in your household develops symptoms (high temperature* or above OR new continuous cough OR loss of/change to sense of taste or smell)

- Do not send your child to school
- Go home ASAP if you are out
- Contact school to inform us
- Whole household to isolate for 14 days
- Get a test for the person with symptoms as soon as possible (online or call 119)

* High temperature means the person feels hot to touch on chest or back (temperature 38°C or above)

Negative test result

- Household stops isolating immediately *as long as no one else has developed symptoms*
- Child can return to school *as long as they do not have a high temperature and they feel well enough*

Positive test result

- Household must continue to isolate
- Contact school to inform us ASAP
- Engage with NHS Test & Trace

If your child tests positive, they must isolate for a minimum of 10 days before they can return to school, *as long as they do not have a high temperature and they feel well.*

They must be brought to school and picked up by someone who is not isolating.

If someone else in the household tests positive, the rest of the household must isolate for 14 days.

If anyone else in the household starts displaying symptoms, they need to stay at home for at least 10 days from when their symptoms appear, regardless of the day of original isolation period.

Contact by NHS Test & Trace

- Do not send your child to school
- Go home ASAP if you are out
- Contact school to inform us
- Whole household isolate for 14 days

No one has symptoms:

> Household must complete 14 day isolation period

Someone in household develops symptoms:

> Household must isolate for 14 days from the day symptoms started
> **Get a test** for the person with symptoms

Negative test result:

> Contact person continues 14 day isolation
> Rest of household stop isolating *as long as no one else has developed symptoms*

Positive test result:

> Person tested must isolate for 10 days from the day symptoms started
> Rest of household isolate for 14 days
