

## "Subject: Live" sessions – Student Guidance

When engaging in live sessions with your teachers, it is important to remember that all interactions should still meet our expectations on behaviour and conduct.

As a member of the school, we continually expect students to get the BASICS right so here is some examples of how they now apply to the remote education environment:

B <sub>e</sub> on Time	<ul> <li>Arrive on time for each "Subject: Live" 'meet' or assembly.</li> <li>Refer to the instructions in ClassCharts for start times and durations.</li> <li>Always allow a few minutes for your device to load or to trouble-shoot sound/camera issues.</li> <li>Be sure to email your teacher in advance if you cannot attend.</li> </ul>
Appearance	<ul> <li>Ensure that your device name is the full name that you are registered with at the school.</li> <li>If this is not the case, staff will not admit you as they may think it is someone from outside of the school/organisation.</li> <li>Once admitted to the 'room' activate your video to enable your teacher to complete a second identity check. Your teacher may then ask you to turn off your video or give you the choice of doing so.</li> <li>You should ensure that you are dressed appropriately for online conversations, as you would in real life.</li> <li>Find an appropriate room/space in your house to join the 'meet'.</li> <li>Please ensure that items in the background are appropriate to be seen – the use of blurred backgrounds are encouraged.</li> </ul>
Stationery and Equipment	<ul> <li>You will need access to an appropriate device with camera and microphone.</li> <li>You should not use your phone or other devices during discussions with teachers unless asked to do so.</li> <li>Students should not take screen shots, photos or recordings of the meetings under any circumstances.</li> <li>Students should have access to a pen and paper/exercise books.</li> </ul>
Instructions	<ul> <li>Follow all instructions 'First Time, Every Time'</li> <li>Normal expectations of behaviour and conduct apply at all times</li> <li>Do not share joining instructions for Google meets/Zoom meetings with anyone else.</li> </ul>
Come Prepared to learn	<ul> <li>Aim to make a contribution to each discussion, either by speaking, 'raising your hand' or by answers questions in the 'chat' feature.</li> <li>Avoid use of the 'Chat' feature unless your teachers ask you to post questions/answers using it.</li> <li>Students who are disruptive will be muted, or removed from the 'meet' if persistently disruptive.</li> </ul>
School Values	<ul> <li>Ambition</li> <li>Pride</li> <li>Happiness</li> <li>Success</li> <li>These values should guide your actions and your</li> <li>actions towards others at all times.</li> </ul>
