### ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL

Please may I remind you that it is **your responsibility** to contact us by 'phone as early as possible (by 9.20am) on the **FIRST DAY** of absence if your child will not be at school. Registers are 'closed' at 9.20 am, any child turning up after this time without good reason will be recorded as unauthorised.

### ARRIVAL TIME

Pupils should arrive between 8.40 – 8.50am. Staff are on duty from 8.40am, so pupils must not come onto site before this time unless of course they are under the supervision of their parent/carer.
