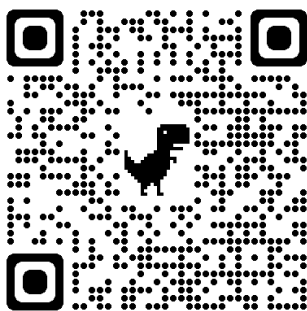
Students and staff alike are encouraged to give £1 to support this fundraising event and all monies will go towards the charity.
