

Acle Academy Summer School July 2021

We offered all year 6 students who were to join us in September 2021 the opportunity to attend our summer school during the week commencing 26th July, between 9.30 and 2.30. The aim of the programme was to deliver a week long summer school, offering a blend of academic education and enrichment activities. We had a really good uptake with 75% of students who were invited attending.

During the week, the provision was structured around both and academic focus around core subjects and developing academic key skills, with the aim of supporting attending pupils to make up for some of their missed education. We also offered small group tuition led by highly-trained and experienced teaching staff from our own setting to further support some pupils which might have fallen behind in their learning due to the circumstances in last year.

The summer school also offered an important opportunity to support pupils' wellbeing, with enrichment activities, such as team games, music, drama or sports activities. Pupils were taught in their form groups and had several opportunities throughout the week to build relationships and get to know their fellow pupils, forge relationships with new teachers and familiarise themselves with their new school environment here at Acle Academy.

We provided transport with pickup point from our main feeder schools and lunch for all students every day throughout the week. All teaching and support staff were provided in house. The SENDCO and Assistant Principal for personal Development were available all week to support with any needs arising, acting as safe guarding leads and a direct link for parents if there was any concerns.
