



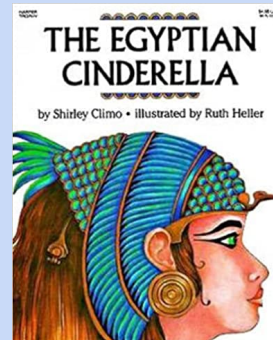
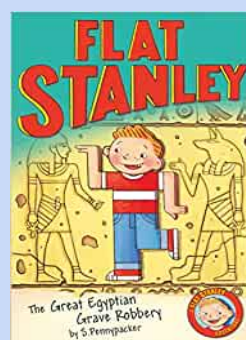
Christmas holiday creative challenge for families: make an Egyptian mummy
You can make it as large or small as you like! It could be just a mummy or be inside a sarcophagus. Please bring your finished creations to school on January 4th so that they can be added to our display. There will be house points for all creations. Have a look online for ideas and use some old packaging cardboard, toilet tubes and paint to make your mummy. You could even stick on some googly eyes - we look forward to seeing your mummy on the first day back.



What Year 3 will be learning about in the next six weeks: history lessons are all about the ancient Egyptians. They will learn and remember key events and dates from the Egyptian era, identify the main geographical features and discover mummification. Excitingly, they will find out about the discovery of one of the most famous tombs in the Valley of the Kings. In science, children will delve deeper into the world of plants and explore germination, carnivorous plants and the fascinating world of fungi.
