

Year 5Curriculum News Christmas/January 21-22












What Year 5 will be learning about in the next six weeks: The title for our learning this half term is We Are Explorers and we will be visiting different areas of the world throughout our curriculum learning. In history, children will learn about the life and adventures of the first female curator at London Zoo, Evelyn cheeseman. In geography lessons, children will study the causes and consequences of deforestation in the Amazon Rainforest and they will think about what can be done to stop it. In science we will continue





to find out about properties of materials before we move on to learning about living things and their habitats. In art, we will focus on landscape, colour and pattern by studying the artwork of Henry Rousseau. Then children will create their own jungle artwork.
