Mental Health & Wellbeing International Day for Elimination of Violence against Women

This week in assemblies we have been learning about the United Nations Spotlight Initiative which aims to end violence against women across the world. Students learnt about what constitutes violence against women which includes denying girls education and rights. Students were asked to reflect on some of the current news and protests concerning the FIFA World Cup being held in Qatar. In addition, students were shown some really important video clips which explained macroaggressions and misogyny that can still be seen in some aspects of our own society. A recent national survey revealed that 66% of 16-18 year olds girls have experienced sexist language at school. Students were encouraged to consider how they can help challenge unacceptable language to help change culture and society.
