From September 2013, the Government have allocated funding directly to schools to support the provision of quality PE and sport. This year Firside Junior School will receive £23,000. This money must be used to give value and provide maximum impact and benefit to our children in PE provision and must be sustainable.

We have allocated the money in the following ways:

- Purchase membership to the West Norfolk & Dereham Schools Sports Partnership to provide the school with support, training for staff and competition opportunities for pupils.
- Purchase of services of a coach from North Walsham Rugby Club to deliver Tag-Rugby training for staff and pupils and competitions.
- Purchase of services from the Community Sports Foundation to provide extra-curricular clubs for Pupil Premium pupils.
- Purchase of annual on-line subscription services for Jump Start Jonny.
- Repair and improve the existing trim-trail equipment.
- Provide a year group set of hi-viz jackets for trips and sporting events.
- Purchase set of sports tops for school sports events.
- Purchase set of school hoodies for staff taking sports and attending sporting events.
- Purchase equipment to enhance all PE lessons and extra-curricular sports.
- Purchase equipment to encourage active play during break and lunch time.
- Purchase Roundnet equipment to support PE lessons.
- Purchase of Trampoline Tennis to support PE lessons.
- Provide supply cover to release PE Lead to attend training/meetings.
- Purchase services of a swimming coach to provide additional swimming sessions for non-swimmers.
