

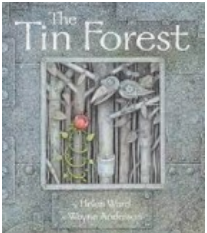
Maths

Multiplication and division: multiples of 10 and related calculations; reasoning about multiplication; 2 digit by 1 digit multiplication (exchanging and no exchanging); links between multiplication and division; dividing a 2 digit by a 1 digit number.

Length and perimeter: millimetres, centimetres and metres; equivalent lengths; comparing lengths; adding lengths; subtracting lengths; measuring and calculating perimeter.

English

We will be studying three texts this term: The Tin Forest (writing a persuasive information leaflet) and The Last Garden (writing our own versions of an extended narrative).



Art / Design and technology

Can buildings be art?

Children will be studying architecture from an art focus. They will be creating skylines and exploring depth.



Geography:

How do you get from A to B?

We start with an introduction to maps, looking at counties, rivers and different OS map symbols. We also look into compass points, and directions through the use of grid references.
