Phonic Screening Check



Phonic Screening Checks will take place the week beginning 12th June 2023. Please ensure that Reading Leads and Headteachers have read the administration <u>guidance</u>. Please also ensure anyone carrying out the check has completed the appropriate <u>training</u>.

The Local Authority has a duty to arrange unannounced visits to 10% of schools for the phonics screening check. The visits may take place just before, during or just after the test or check weeks.

Success for All - FFT are holding <u>free CPD</u> with Christopher Such. They will also be releasing Y2 spelling scheme, suitable for any SSP


Reporting PSC Scores



Partner and Graduate Schools are required to submit their PSC scores to us no later than 30th June 2023.

This year schools must submit an overall % for those who met the expected pass mark as well as a list of each child's individual score. An email will be sent to Reading Leads nearer to the time to remind them how to submit this.
