
Fabulous learning - June Principal's Awards

Next year - new school skirts

Ready for September, we will be introducing a new school skirt to replace the straight skirt that is currently available. We have had a number of issues over the years with the straight skirt including poor fit, seams breaking and many girls choosing to roll the skirt up to unacceptable levels. The new skirt will be a straight fit with two pleats at the front which will allow more movement and flexibility for girls. The pleated full skirt will still be available. 
