Since the government allocation, from September 2013, of funding to schools in order to support the provision and quality of P.E. and sport we endeavour to utilise this to get the best value for money and maximise its impact across the school. This year we will approximately receive £17,500.

As a result of the additional funding we aim to:

- * Provide time for subjects leads to meet through supply costs to enable discussions around PE assessment and curriculum development.
- * Provide a variety of activities to promote 'Health Week' to support children's mental and physical wellbeing.
- * Take part in workshops and festivals run by 'North Walsham Rugby Club'
- * Purchase new equipment to promote the development of 'Gross-motor' and 'Fine-motor' skills across EYFS.
- * Purchase new equipment to develop core strength, balance and gross motor skills...
- * Offer a variety of afterschool clubs including multiskills, yoga, dance and fitness club
- * Provide CPD to teachers to continually improve teaching and learning.
- * Take part in 'Healthy Happy Active' workshops to promote positive mental health and wellbeing
