

This week, we received our SATs results for our current Year 6 children. These are standard national tests that all Year 6 children take in Maths, Reading and Grammar, Spelling & Punctuation. The children also have a Writing assessment grade that teachers award them. We are delighted with the results this year:

- √ 87% of our children achieved the expected standard or better in Reading the National Average is 73%
- √ 80% of our children achieved the expected standard or better in Writing the National Average is 71%
- ✓ 80% of our children achieved the expected standard or better in Maths the National Average is 73%
- ✓ 73% of our children achieved the expected standard or better in their combined score in Reading, Writing and Maths the National Average is 59%
- ✓ 63% of our children achieved the expected standard or better in GPS the National Average is 72%

As a staff team, we are thrilled that these children are leaving our primary school very ready for the next stage of learning and a true testament to their amazing hard work over the last 7 years, alongside the dedicated and committed hard working staff. We are all immensely proud of them and I'm sure you all are too ©


