SAFEGUARDING

WHAT TO DO IF A CHILD DISCLOSES TO YOU?



Do NOT

- Don't promise confidentiality -
 - Don't ask leading questions-
- Don't use your own words to describe something the child has said
 - Don't investigate -
- Don't wait to report a disclosure -

- Listen carefully
- Make accurate notes using the child's words and date and sign these
- Reassure the child has done the correct thing by telling you.
 - Inform a designated safeguarding lead
