Contact Details - Reminder

Please ensure that you keep us up to date with all your contact details.

Timings for the school day - Reminder

Soft Start: The double gates will be locked at **8.30am** and children/parents are welcome onto the playground. Children can come into school from this time. Please ensure that you only come onto the playground once the double gates are closed. The children will be greeted in their classroom with early morning refreshments and activities ready to start the day. All children should be in school by **8.45am** as this is when we officially start the school day.

The playground equipment is not for use prior to the start of the school day. End of Day: The end of the school day is 3pm please ensure that children are picked up on time.

PE days: Children are asked to come into school dressed in their PE kits on days when they have PE. Please ensure that children are equipped with the correct kit in line with our uniform policy which can be found on our website. Reception children will start their official PE lessons after Christmas. Woodpeckers Class have PE on Monday & Friday, Butterflies have PE on Tuesday & Wednesday and Hedgehogs have PE on Wednesday & Thursday.

Attendance

Attendance and great routines are important for all our children to make the best progress in school along with supporting children in their social skills and routines. Unless children really are too unwell to come to school we do ask that they are always present.

Medical and dental appointments should be made outside of the school day – if this is unavoidable please ensure that we are provided with evidence of appointment confirmation for our attendance records.

Please ensure you inform us each day if your child is unwell. The Office opens at 7.30am each morning.

As we approach the end of this half term we will be analysing attendance data and sending letters to inform you of your child's current attendance percentage – this is a data driven exercise and if attendance is lower, there will be the offer of support via a conversation with you.
