### Why is going to the toilet so disruptive?



Number of times the lesson is disrupted for 1 toilet visit	Why?
1	Student asks to go to the toilet
2	Teacher has to stop teaching to request on-call
3	On-call arrive to take student, disrupting the lesson.
4	Student returns to the lesson, disrupting the lesson.
5	Teacher has to spend time going over what you missed, rather than helping someone who doesn't understand.

### Why do we have to use on-call?

- ✓ Prevent truancy
- ✓ Prevent vandalism
- ✓ Prevent vaping and smoking
- ✓ Prevent large groups gathering in the toilets and intimidating younger students.

### What can I do about it?

1. Use your time wisely. Your priorities during break and lunch should be:

- Eating
- Drinking
- Going to the toilet
- Speaking to HoH if needed.

2. Don't down a whole bottle of water at the start of the lesson!

Drinking slowly is better for you and is less likely to result in an urgent toilet visit being necessary.
