Parents' Evenings

Smoking/vaping onsite

Please can I remind you that we are a 'non-smoking' site, as are all schools, so could you refrain from smoking or vaping on site. Please can all families remind all members of families or others, who might be collecting children and they aren't familiar with the school site and signage - thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

Children arriving early at school

The side-school gate opens at just before 8.30am to enable children to attend sensory circuits in the hall or to walk down to Nursery for 8.30am. Children and families should only be entering the school site at that time please. We are finding that some Year 5 and Year 6 children who are walking to school, are arriving at the gate at just after 8am. This is far too early for school and are not being supervised by any adults or parents. Please can we ask that any children that are walking to school are reminded by parents to arrive at the school gates at 8.30am and no sooner. This is for their own safety as we cannot be supervising children before 8.30am and who aren't on school site. Thank you for your support with this.

Staffing changes for the Summer Term

Unfortunately, we are saying goodbye to Mrs Martin who will be leaving us at the end the Easter holidays to take up a new teaching position, much closer to where she lives in the Summer Term. Mrs Martin came to Wells Nursery & Primary School after having worked at Burnham Market Primary School first and so collectively, we are so grateful for the amazing work and dedication that she has had towards our children for a few years now, across the 2 schools. We wish her every success as she moves onto a school closer to home and are very grateful for the long commute she has had for a while now.

As both Mrs Norman and Mrs Martin will be leaving us now at the same time, Mrs Beck will be based outside the classroom so that between Mrs Beck and myself, we will be the Senior Leadership Team for the interim period of just the Summer Term, whilst we advertise for a new structure from September 2024 onwards. This is being decided centrally at the Wensum Trust and then we will let you know the structure as soon as this is formed. We will be advertising for a Year 4 and a Year R teacher for the Summer term and will inform you of the appointments as soon as they have been made. We recognise that this is an unsettling time as 2 senior staff will be leaving at the same time, and Mrs Beck and I will be a consistent presence in school for the Summer Term because of this.
