
- Uniform in school colours can be bought from most high street retailers school badges are available from the school office

## **Attendance**

We are committed to helping every child develop into a high achieving, confident, healthy and resilient person, creating a pathway to support their future aspirations, independence and contribution to society.

In order to do this we know that every day your child is in school counts. Research commissioned by the Department for Education shows missing school for even a day can mean a child is less likely to achieve good grades, which can have a damaging effect on their life chances. Our aim is to work with parents and carers to ensure that all our pupils receive the most from their education and reach their full potential.

As you may be aware, we are required by the local Authority to look at our attendance levels on a regular basis and our attendance target is 96%
