

Year 4 Spring 2 Plan for Parents

Maths

In our Maths lessons this half term, we will be exploring the 12x table and multiples of 12. We will also be revising the concept of decimals and how they link to our knowledge of fractions. We will be writing tenths and hundredths in decimals and rounding numbers to the nearest whole number. We will also practise adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator that are greater than one. In all our Maths lessons, we will be developing our reasoning, fluency and problem solving skills.

Our Value

Our value this half term is Thoughtfulness. We will think about our value during our class assembly and through other links in the curriculum. We will also celebrate it with our Values award.

English

Our English lessons will continue to be inspired by the book 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes. We will be planning and writing our own mystery stories, before publishing them into books.

We will also be revising key grammar, punctuation and spelling concepts.

We will also continue to develop our reading skills through our daily Guided Reading sessions.

Science

This half term, we are continuing our learning about States of Matter. We will be exploring the particles of solids, liquids and gases and how these are different. We will be exploring the concepts of condensation and evaporation and the part they play in the Water Cycle. We will develop our working scientifically skills through a range of practical investigations and activities within our lessons.
