Memories of World Book Day, by Mr. Bates

Thursday 7th March was World Book Day and I had the sincere pleasure of sharing this important day with the publishing date of my new children's picture book, Keep up, Duck. The children gathered in the hall for our early morning assembly, all dressed up as some of their favourite literary characters, and looking resplendent in their colourful costumes. We explored how a book is conceived, developed, written, illustrated and published, and had the pleasure of seeing the book's promotional film made by our very own Mr. Williams. The rest of the day included the making of storyboards, discussing our favourite stories, a reading carousel and the purchasing of books with gifted book tokens. In this digital age, it becomes all the more important for us and our children to cherish the value of books. Every meaningful emotion, event and idea has been written in a book, and its power remains as potent and as important today as it was at the time of the Gutenberg printing press, over 500 years ago. To see how the children embraced the pleasure of reading, story-telling and a general love of books is a heart-warming sign for the future. It was a privilege to share it with them.
