Develop positive attitudes towards and stamina for writing:

- I can write a narrative about personal experiences and those of others (real and fictional).
- I can write for different purposes.

Consider what they are going to write before beginning:

- I can write down ideas and/or key words, including new vocabulary.
- I can encapsulate what I want to say, sentence by sentence.

Vocabulary, Grammar & Punctuation:

- •I can use capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks to demarcate sentences.
- I know how the grammatical patterns in a sentence indicate its function as a statement, question, exclamation or command.
- I can use expanded noun phrases to describe and specify [for example, the blue butterfly].
- I can use the past tense correctly and consistently, including the progressive form.
- I can use subordination (using when, if, that, or because) to add more detail to my sentences.
- I can use co-ordination (using or, and, or but).
- I can make the correct choice and show consistent use of present tense and past tense throughout my writing.
- I can use commas to separate items in a list.

Money

Year 1:

• I can recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes.

Year 2:

- I can recognise and use symbols for pounds (£) and pence (p) and combine amounts to make a particular value.
- I can find different combinations of coins that equal the same amounts of money.
- I can solve simple problems in a practical context involving addition and subtraction of money of the same unit, including giving change.

Fractions

Year 1:

- I can recognise, find and name a half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.
- I can recognise, find and name a quarter as one of four equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.

Year 2:

- I can recognise, find, name and write fractions 1/3, 1/4 and 2/4 of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity.
- I can write simple fractions for example, ½ of 6 = 3 and recognise the equivalence of 2/4 and 1/2.

I know the value of different coins and can make an amount.

I can find fractions of a shape or quantity.



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Science	Living Things and Their Habitats I can: Say what is different about things that are living, dead or have never been alive. Identify some of the plants and animals in a familiar habitat. Sort objects into categories. Find microhabitats. Describe the conditions in a habitat. Ask questions about different habitats. Describe the characteristics of some plants and animals. Name some sources of food.

Social Emotional	Year 1 - I can correctly name the main parts of the body, including external genitalia using scientific terms. Year 2 - I can recognise how I grow and will change as I become older.
