#### Welcome back and welcome to new staff

We do hope that you have had a great Easter holiday and we are delighted to welcome all families back to school this week. A special welcome to Miss Beard, our new Year 4 teacher and to Miss Craske, our new Year R teacher working with Mrs Beck. We are so pleased to have you back on the teaching team here and wish you a great term with us. Roll on some sunshine for the Summer Term! May I remind you that in the interim period as we appoint new permanent staff, Mrs Beck is our Acting-Deputy Headteacher (5 days a week) and myself, Mrs Stroulger, am here at least 3 days a week (Monday-Wednesday). #### **New Term Reminders**

As we start a new term there are a few things that we'd like to remind families about – many thanks for your cooperation with these:

- 1) Ordering Lunches Lunches should be ordered by parents/carers on Scopay. This can be done until 8.30 am on the day that lunch is required. Children should not be routinely ordering their lunch in the classroom. Lunches should only be ordered in the classroom or school office in exceptional circumstances.
- 2) Start and End of the School Day The school gates open at 8.30am Children enter school for registration at 8.45am, and finish at 3.15pm. Regular lateness makes it very difficult for teachers to begin the school day promptly so we kindly ask for you to make sure your children arrive on time. Phonics starts promptly as soon as the children are in school and this is a vital part of the school day, which we do not want children to miss.
- 3) Illness/Collection Please telephone or Dojo the school office, not your class Teacher/TA if your child is ill or you need to change the time of collection, person collecting or to let us know that your child will be late. Teachers and TAs can often miss messages through the school day as they are teaching, so please contact the school office to make sure your message is received. The answerphone is checked very regularly throughout the day so please do leave a message if we are unable to answer your call.
- 4) **Parking** There are an increasing number of cars parking outside the school on the double yellow and zigzag lines, and in the turning circle. This is a very real risk to families trying to safely walk in and out of the school, as well as stopping the buses from safely collecting children. Please do not use the staff car park at any time Parking is available along Polka Road and in the Co-Op car park.

#### New Ultimate Frisbee After-school Club

Active Education will be running an Ultimate Frisbee After-school club every Monday from 3.15-4.15pm instead of Kwik Cricket for this half term. It will begin next Monday, 22<sup>nd</sup> April and is open to Years 2-6. There are still some spaces available to book on Scopay.
