Ongoing support and staff development for long term sustainable benefits

Children's confidence and enjoyment are increased.  
Teachers will have skills to teach Tag Rugby.

Children will be signposted to outside agencies. PE promoted in school.

High quality teaching and learning of PE across whole school (Reception-Year 2).

Children given the opportunity to be more active during lunchtimes.

EYFS bukes are well protected and looked after for future use.

Workshop planning provided for teachers to use on a regular basis within the classroom to support children's mental health and wellbeing.

Children learn a new skill which they can use within their play (EYFS) and at playtimes/lunchtimes. This will help support physical activity during this time as well as having a positive impact on their mental health and wellbeing.

Promoting physical activity and enjoyment throughout the day to support children's health and concentration.

Children and their families become more active outside of school and physical activity is celebrated and rewarded.

Sport equipment is safe and fit for purpose.
