



KEYWORDS...

Observe: to look

Tone: refers to the degree of lightness or darkness of an area: tone creates form.

Shading: is used to create different *tones* in a *drawing*.

Three-dimensional form: the drawing looks realistic and the shape is clearly recognizable.

Illusion: a trick of the eye.

Ellipse: a circle seen in perspective



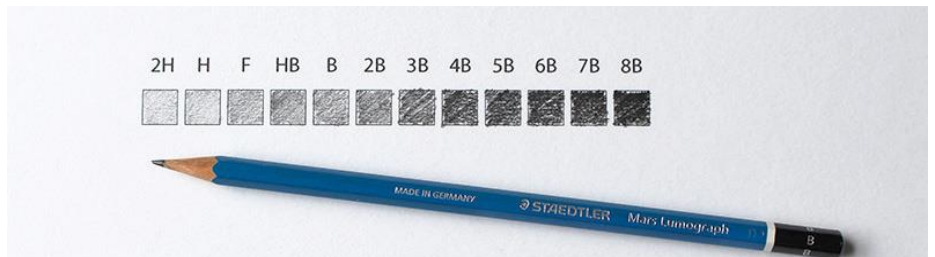
H: Hard

F: Fine Point

HB: Hard Black

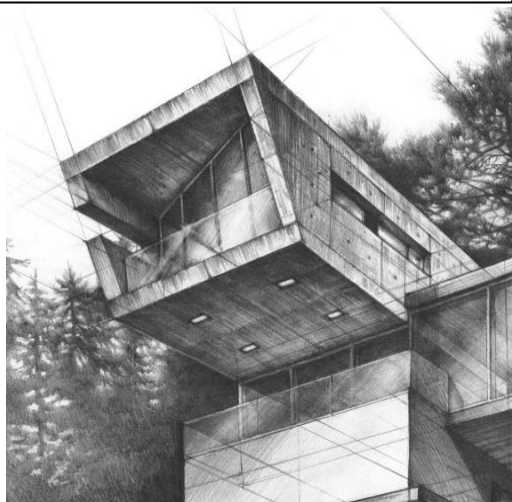
B: Black

Texture: the feel or appearance of a surface, how rough or smooth it is.



H pencils are harder and produce lighter lines

B pencils are softer and produce darker lines
