It has been great to welcome back our Y13 students and see how well they have settled in to their final year in Sixth Form. They have really ‘hit the ground running’ in terms of their lessons and academic work. This term is also very much about Next Steps and students and Tutors have been working hard on Personal Statements and University applications. This is an exciting time, but can also be an anxious time, as students start making adult decisions about their futures – including where they want to study when they leave Sixth Form.

We also welcomed our new Y12s, many of whom came from last year's Y11, but also a good number who have joined us from other local high schools. As well as sorting out the subjects they will be studying for the next two years and starting to make the jump from GCSE to A Level /Level 3 Btecs they have started the Helleston Community Project (HCP). This is a unique experience for our Sixth Formers and allows them to develop not only life and leadership skills, but also take part in workshops with local organisations on subjects as diverse as Mental Health, homelessness and safe driving skills. The highlight of the Project is a day pushing themselves out of their ‘comfort zones’ at a local activity centre with activities such as canoeing, climbing and abseiling. The project ends with two days of charity events to raise money for local goods causes
