Starter Tasks at Hellesdon High School

Teachers often use starter tasks to encourage students to recall previously learned information. This helps the knowledge to stick in your long term memory. Starter tasks also help students to successfully transition from one lesson to the next.


Pace is also crucial in your lessons because it helps to keep students engaged in their learning. Teachers have been using timers during starter tasks and at other points in lessons to help you to focus. By establishing the right level of pace, teachers can ensure that students stay motivated and focused, making it easier for you to absorb new information and practice skills.

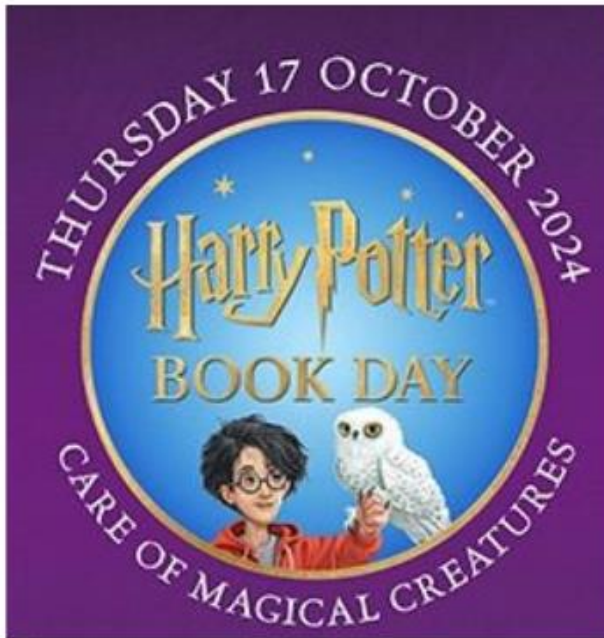
