### MESSAGE FROM – MR EARL, PRINCIPAL

Last Sunday was Remembrance Day and an opportunity to take some time out of our busy schedules to reflect and remember all those that lost their lives not only during World War I and; World War II, but also in more recent conflicts and wars.

Today at 11:00am the school will pause for 2 minutes to commemorate all those that have lost their lives in these conflicts and House Assemblies for the week will further reflect on this. I have attached a link to a short video from the children's author Tom Palmer who each year creates a short film reflecting what this means to him and how this has inspired him to write his children novels.

My annual Remembrance Day film– hundreds of Allied planes crashed in the countryside during the defence of Britain during the Second World War, some miles away from villages and roads, many hundreds of feet high up mountains and fells. Thousands of airmen were killed and severely injured. Many sites have memorials to those lost. Tom speaks from the site of one of these air crashes.
