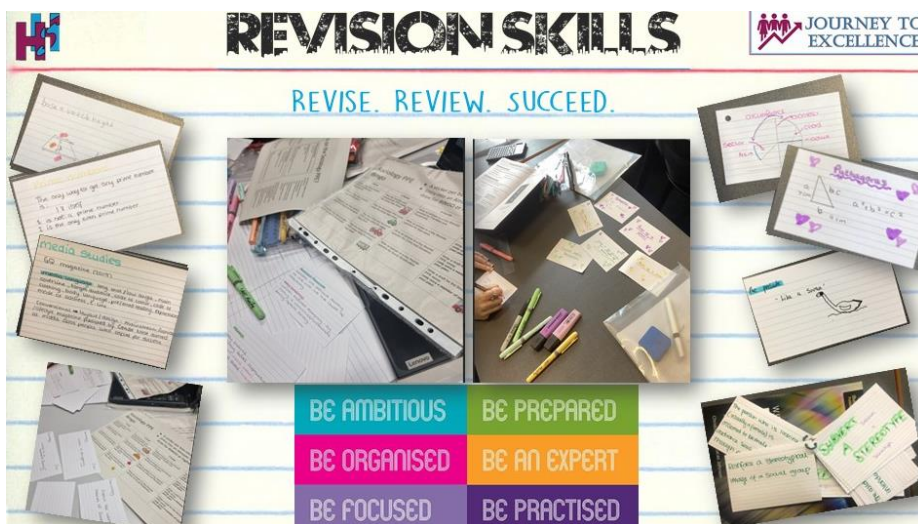


Revision Week 1 - Flashcards
