### Re: Remote Learning Arrangements – Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> January 2025

Dear Parents and Carers

Further to the notification earlier today regarding the school closure tomorrow (Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> January 2025), I would like to confirm the remote learning arrangements for your child's timetabled lessons.

This afternoon, school staff have been working to set remote learning in place for each lesson they were due to teach. The details for all lessons will be posted on [ClassCharts](#) by 09:00 tomorrow morning.

In many cases, this will re-direct students to other platforms such as Google Classroom and Seneca learning. However, we have asked that all work be posted onto ClassCharts as the single place for all work to be organised.

The work that has been set should be manageable, reasonable and accessible for all pupils. We recognise that in some households there may be difficulties related to broadband connections or availability of devices. No students will be penalised if this is the case and we are happy to support where possible.

Students are also free to choose which order they undertake each lesson to allow flexibility if, for example, they are sharing devices with other siblings.

If students are unable to access their ClassCharts account, then please email Mrs Ryder (Data Manager) at [datamanager@aldermanpeel.norfolk.sch.uk](mailto:datamanager@aldermanpeel.norfolk.sch.uk) and she will assist as quickly as possible.

School reception will also be closed tomorrow. Therefore, if you have any general enquiries or difficulties, please email [office@aldermanpeel.norfolk.sch.uk](mailto:office@aldermanpeel.norfolk.sch.uk) as this will be monitored continuously throughout the day.

We apologise for the disruption that this unavoidable closure will cause, however, the response we have received from our school community so far has been very positive. I would therefore like to take this opportunity to thank you for your support and understanding.
