### Punctuality

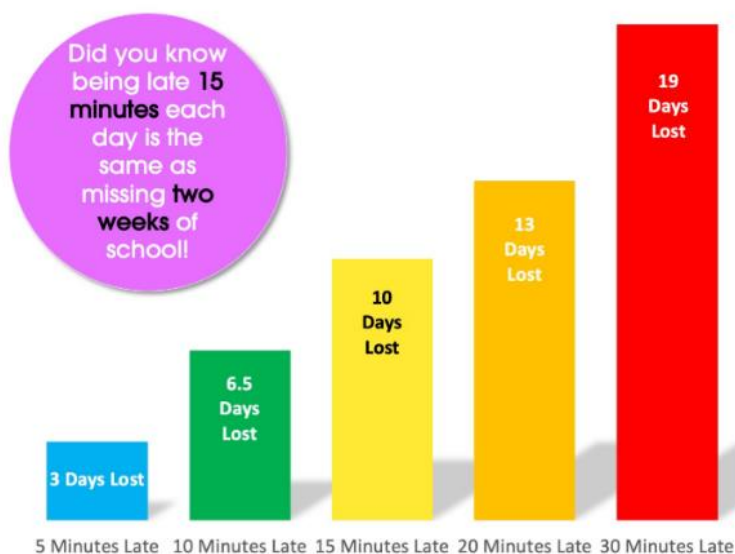

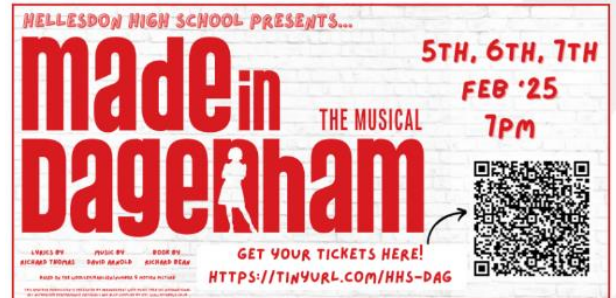
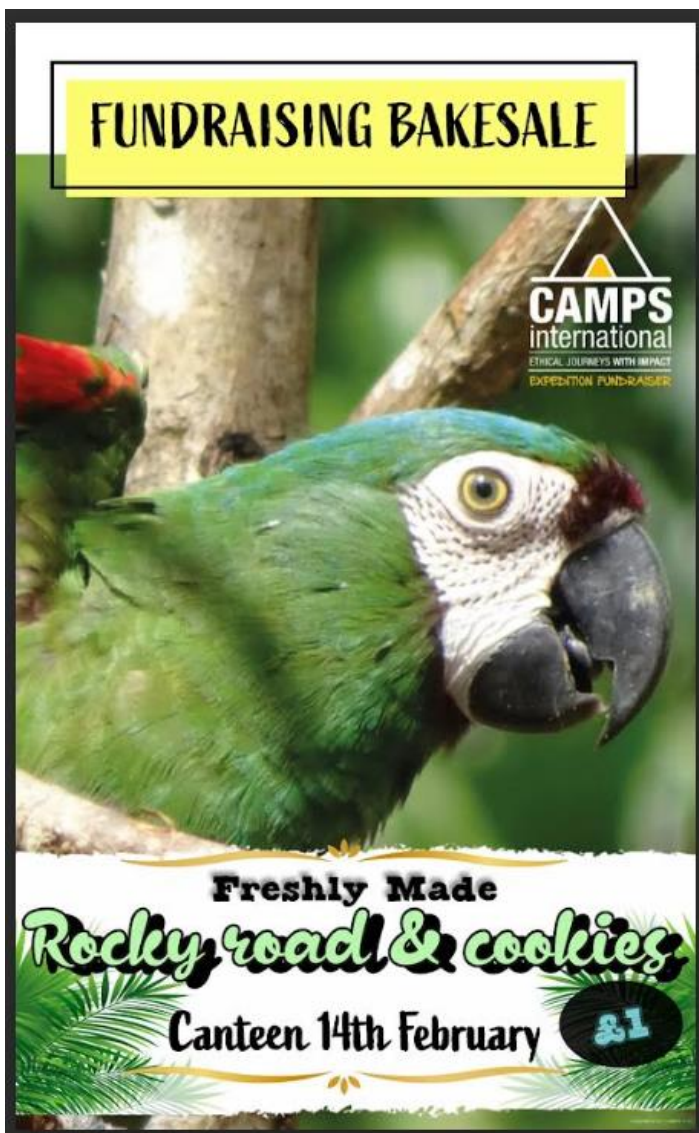
