On Tuesday morning we met with our Year 11 students as part of our weekly Journey to Excellence assemblies. We celebrated a very positive PPE week and praised students for achieving a weekly attendance figure above that of the National Average.

We then moved onto the rewards! This year all Year 11 students are working towards their Passport To Prom. Students have to reach the following standards in order to qualify for a prom ticket;

- 1) Attendance of 95% or above (Starting 12 February 2025)
- 2) Conduct score of 95% or above
- 3) Reach 25 Academic Intervention Sessions or more

If students manage to reach **one of the above** standards by the time the summer exams begin, they will qualify for the Bronze Award which will get them an invite to the Y11 Prom. If they reach two of the standards, they will hit the Silver Award which gets them a £5 discount off of their ticket. Finally, if all three standards are met, the Gold Award will result in a £10 prom ticket discount.

In addition, each week, tutor groups are battling it out to gain the highest average attendance, conduct and intervention sessions and this week we rewarded the following tutor groups with a bucket of sweets;

Attendance – 11CAM 98.7%

Conduct – 11GL 97%

Intervention Sessions – 11HWD 4.5 average
