## Home Learning Developments

As part of our ongoing commitment to supporting students' learning both in and out of the classroom, we would like to share with you some further improvements to our home learning system. These changes have been developed in response to feedback from students, parents/carers, and staff, and are designed to make the home learning system more accessible, engaging, and effective for everyone involved.

### Rewards for Positive Home Learning Habits

- We will continue to celebrate effort and dedication to home learning via our rewards system and school shop. Our current system includes the following.
- Verbal praise and recognition during class. Students will achieve Home Learning achievement marks on ClassCharts. These will carry greater value so will enable your child to build up a higher number of positive marks on their class chart ratio. (1x achievement mark for completion, 2x for 'good' quality work and 3x for 'outstanding' work.)
- Along with other positive marks gained in lessons and around the school, students will be able to use these marks as credit to purchase items from the rewards shop.
- Opportunities to participate in special activities or events as a reward for consistent completion of home learning.
- Positive communication with parents to celebrate your child's hard work.

### ClassCharts

We will be using ClassCharts to set home learning tasks moving forward. This will enable students and parents/carers to easily check work set and due via their ClassCharts App. We will still use Google Classroom and other platforms to complete assignments and to share classwork, but assignments will be set in ClassCharts with links to take students to the different platforms for completion. All tasks will be set on Mondays with clear timescales and dates for completion/submission.

### Support for Missed or Incomplete Home Learning

We have streamlined our system for support and incomplete home learning.

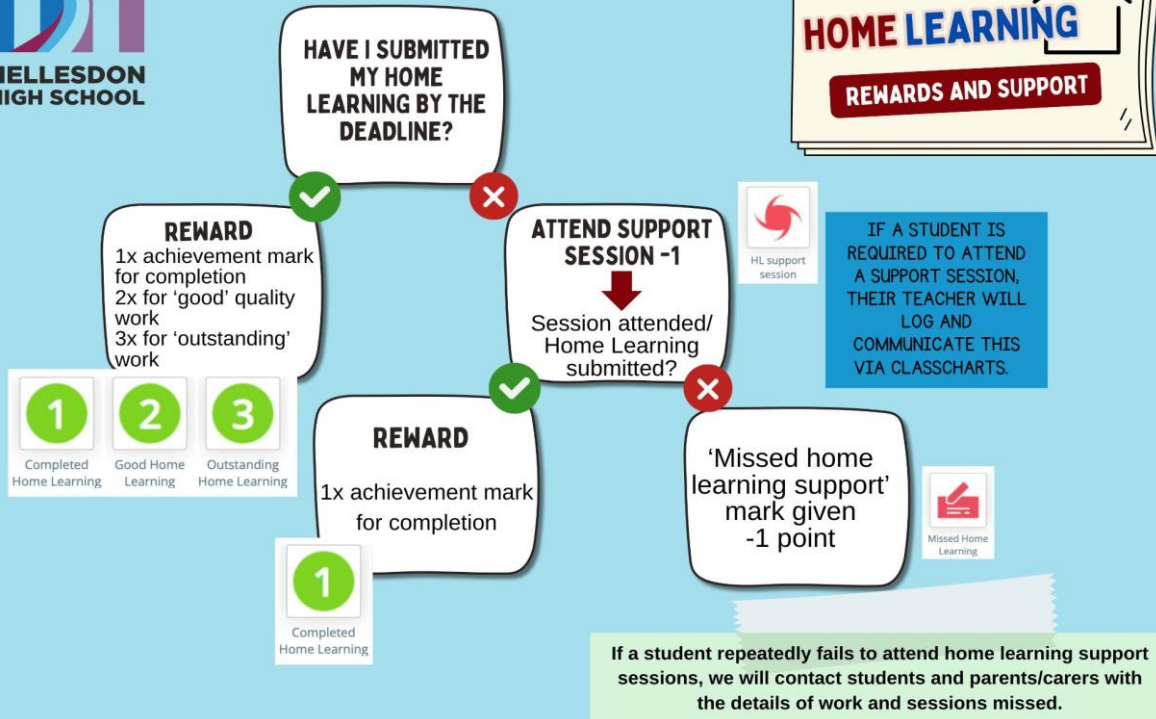
- All departments will provide a weekly support session for students.
- If home learning is incomplete or missed, the student will be awarded a negative mark and allocated a support session on a specific date and time during break or lunch. The information will be communicated via ClassCharts and will show as a D15. Once attended, a positive mark will be allocated to counteract the previous negative.
- If the support session is missed, the student will be awarded a further negative Missed Home Learning Mark.

*3x instances of incomplete home learning will be referred for subsequent support/intervention.*
