Rewards System

The beginning of term provides us with the perfect opportunity to share with you some details about our exciting new rewards system, starting this September, 2025! We have taken feedback from students, staff and parents/carers in order to provide as many opportunities as possible to meaningfully recognise and reward the outstanding achievements of our students.

The new rewards system has been planned out across the school year, ensuring that students have the opportunity to have their achievements recognised on a regular basis. We are moving to a programme that provides more frequent opportunities for recognition, which we hope will be more motivational and rewarding for our students. Please read the table below for a summary of the rewards that your child will benefit from this year;

Reward	Details
Star of the Week	Each week, in assembly, Heads of Year will choose their "Star(s) of the Week". These will be students who have been recognised for going above and beyond, whether that be related to their positive attitude, effort, choices or improvement. Winners will receive a certificate.
Learning Legends	Staff will be able to recommend students for weekly "Learning Legend" awards. These certificates will be handed out by members of the Senior Leadership Team in classes, every Friday. As the name suggests, these awards relate to positive attitudes to learning.
The Rewards Store	Students earn positive points in school that can be used as currency in the Rewards Store on ClassCharts. The store will be filled with a range of fun and useful bits and pieces, such as stationery and stickers.
Attendance Streaks	Each term, students are encouraged to maintain a 100% attendance for as long as possible. The longer they maintain their "Streak" of consecutive days in school, the greater the reward!
Postcards Home	Staff will issue "Postcards" when they wish to notify a parent or carer of a student's excellent conduct, work or attitude in school.
Achievement Milestones	When students hit the next achievement milestone e.g. 50/ 100/ 250 achievement points, they will receive a certificate.
Celebration of Success Events	These will take place before Christmas and at the end of the Summer Term. Each year-group has a presentation in which awards are given for endeavour and achievement across all subjects. Parents/Carers of award winners will be invited into school to watch their child collect their award.

Reward	Details
The Snow-Ball!	An end-of-term Christmas School Disco for students in Year 7 and 8!
Half-Term Cinema	Students have the chance to save up their Rewards Store Points in order to buy tickets to a showing of a popular age appropriate film. These events will take place once each term.
End-of-Term Rewards Events	Larger-scale reward events such as inflatable obstacle courses! These will be open to the majority of students and will take place at the end of each term.
Passport to Prom	Focused on Year 11 Students only. Students aim to meet high standards of attitude, attendance and conduct. Students earn discounts off the cost of their Prom Ticket!

Not only will students be recognised and rewarded in assembly and in class, they will also have their achievements shared more widely within the school community, for example, on the Principal's Weekly Bulletin.
