OUR facilities

Having spent over £278,000 on updating and upgrading the facilities, Hellesdon Sixth Form is a fantastic place for you to both study and relax with friends.

The fully refurbished Sixth Form has a large Study Centre - a quiet, purposeful environment where you will have access to one of more than 70 PCs and laptops.

The area is where you will spend allocated time when you're not in lessons to complete homework or research areas in subjects and it is staffed by a Study Centre Supervisor who is on hand to help you with any issues that may arise.

With our growth in student numbers in recent years we have doubled the size of the Common Room to ensure you have somewhere to relax and socialise during the breaks between lessons or at the start/end of the day.

You have access to a comfortable seating area, as well as a kitchen to make food and hot drinks.

Both the Study Centre and the Common Room are equipped with WiFi, enabling you to work on your own devices should you wish to.

Supporting YOU ON YOUR NEXT STEP

As a new Year 12 student, you will have a dedicated Head of Year who oversees your transition and ensures you make a positive start on your next step with us. Our full time Pastoral Officer is also there for those times you may need some extra support and guidance.

You will also be assigned a Personal Tutor who oversees both your academic progress and pastoral support over your two years at Hellesdon. Our tutors are experienced in supporting you as you progress through Sixth Form, guiding you to your next step.

Post-16 teachers at Hellesdon are experts in their fields, whether it's A-Levels in the more traditional subjects or the wide range of vocational subjects we offer.

We deliberately keep class sizes smaller so you can benefit from the more independent and focused learning that takes place at Post-16 level.

You also have access to specialist science laboratories and creative facilities, including an Art Workroom used exclusively for Sixth Form students.



Valuable LEARNING

Beyond an outstanding Sixth Form education, we also provide a host of enrichment opportunities outside the classroom. These activities provide valuable experiences and additional skill sets.

Ranging from subject trips to our weekly conference, where you hear from guest speakers on diverse areas such as political and environment issues, and health topics.

All students have work experience as part of their Programme of Study, aimed to enhance your future prospects with guidance on interviews and application processes.

The opportunity to become a Student Leader is highly valued by our students - whether that is mentoring younger pupils or being part of the Senior Student Leadership Team and helping shape the student experience at Hellesdon.

Football and Education Programmes

The Football and Education Programme for boys is a football-focussed offering that replicates the professional environment. Players have aspirations to further their on-pitch development whilst also building a dual career pathway at the same time.

The Football and Education Programme for girls is a football-focused offering that provides a direct link into Norwich City Women's FC and potential exit routes into overseas scholarships and the national league structure.

The Football Learning Programme has a wider football perspective with more focus on careers development for those considering a non-playing career in sport, such as coaching, media or science-based progressions.

Sports Coaching programme

The Sports Coaching Programme provides a unique offering that combines a core academic offer alongside additional sports coaching qualifications and enrichment opportunities.

For those looking to pursue a career in "something sporty" the two-year offering gives a wide-ranging insight across the full sporting sector, whilst achieving 3 A-levels and an industry-recognised coaching qualification in the process.

The course is designed to promote a pathway into both PE teaching and coaching across a variety of different sports, it certainly isn't all about football!

Through the programme's UEA partnership, the university will be supporting students with their degree level exit routes and potential PGCE progression, alongside additional academic support and site visits to the university campus, ensuring students are well supported to achieve positive exit routes.

Your TYPICAL DAY AT SIXTH FORM

Ask any student and they will tell you that life at Hellesdon Sixth Form is busy!

Monday to Wednesday starts with Tutor Time - an opportunity to discuss things in a group of around 15 students with an experienced Post-16 Tutor.

Thursday and Friday follows on with individual mentoring across the term Here students build up a good working relationship with their Tutor and discuss any academic and pastoral issues or goals.

It's then off to lessons.

Subject specific lessons are delivered by specialist Post-16 teachers, in well-equipped classrooms, who will challenge you to think and help develop the skills needed to gain top grades.

When students are not in lessons, they follow a pattern of timetabled private studies. These take place in the Study Centre, equipped with the latest PCs and laptops where students are able to work in a quiet and focused environment.

The extra freedom in Sixth Form also means that when students are not in lessons they have time to relax in the common room or go home if they choose. Many however decide to get ahead with work in the Study Centre.

During break and lunchtime students enjoy using the common room, with its well equipped kitchen and comfortable seating, giving time to relax and catch up with friends.

Unique to Hellesdon Sixth Form is our weekly Conference.

This is a meeting for the whole year group, with guest speakers and opportunities to take part in extracurricular activities throughout the year.

All-in-all a very busy, but enjoyable time. Believe us - the two years pass very quickly!

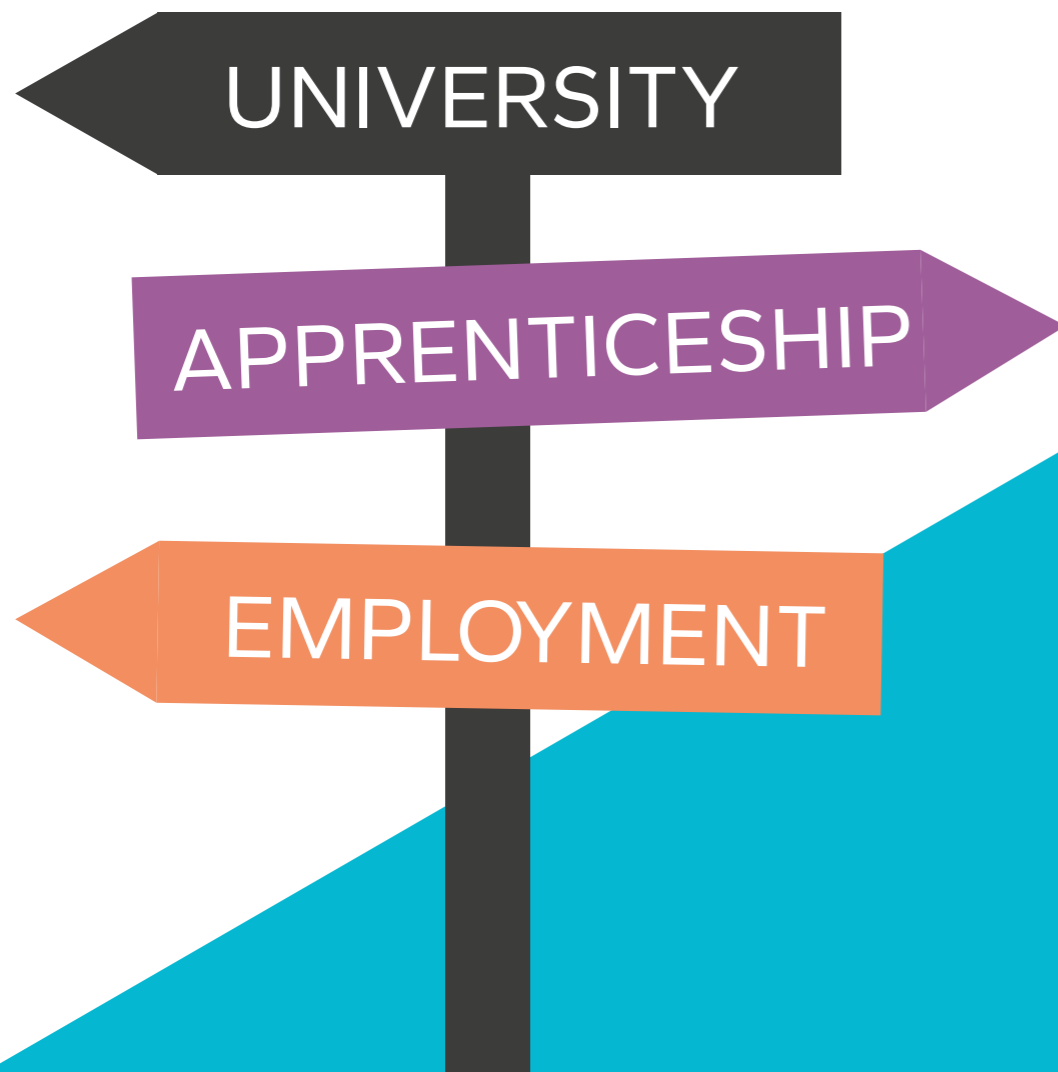

Whether it's a top university, Higher Level Apprenticeship with a national firm, or employment locally, students benefit from a structured 'Post-18 Choices' programme. This individually tailored programme, partnered with the UEA, allows students to investigate all their options before deciding on the route they wish to take.

Individual guidance is available from tutors and outside agencies to ensure every student progresses on to a fulfilling future. Students looking to apply to Oxbridge and Russell Group universities have a bespoke application programme to ensure they are fully prepared for the process.

If you live locally, we would recommend you walk or bike to Hellesdon Sixth Form.

drive

For Sixth Form students who have a full driver's licence and want to travel in by car, a parking permit is required. You can get one of these in agreement with the Head of Year in return for a donation of £10 towards the Sixth Form's chosen charity.

bus

Norfolk County Council currently run school bus services between Horsford, Newton St Faith, Felthorpe and Hellesdon Sixth Form. In order to use this transport you will need to apply to the Post 16 travel scheme. All the details about the scheme are on the Norfolk County Council website.

First Bus also run services from Hellesdon to Norwich City Centre, Long Stratton, Harleston and Mulbarton, whilst Sanders Coaches run bus services between Aylsham and Hellesdon.
