

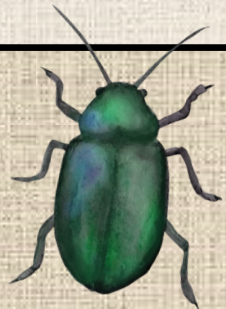
## This week we have:

- In Maths, Year 1 have been learning to sorting, counting and representing objects. Year 2 have been grouping and counting objects in tens and also begun to represent numbers on a place value grid, using tens and ones.
- Year 2—English—We have been thinking about what we didn't do in the summer holidays. For example we didn't go swimming with sharks. The children acted out their chosen idea through charades and then wrote a simple sentence, thinking about their pull stops, capital letters and finger spaces.
