Eligibility:

- ✓ No more than 5 missed days during next 100 school days.*
(22nd September – 12th March)
- ✓ No more than 5 missed days during the last 50 school days.*
(12th March – 12th June)
- ✓ Attendance to all exams
- ✓ Amber or Green AtL Score (March)
- ✓ Behaviour Record/Stage of policy

*Unless exceptional circumstances (i.e. medical)



95%	=	47 LESSONS MISSED EACH YEAR 8 days in total or 1 week and 3 days
90%	=	95 LESSONS MISSED EACH YEAR 16 days in total or 3 weeks and 1 day
85%	=	142 LESSONS MISSED EACH YEAR 24 days in total or 4 weeks and 4 days
80%	=	190 LESSONS MISSED EACH YEAR 32 days in total or 6 weeks and 2 days
